August 20	<b>Fees Due for ALL REMAINING FALL 2025 PROGRAMS</b> All fees due by 4:00 pm, including Fee Deferrals, to avoid deregistration from all courses

<b>December 17</b>	<b>Fees Due for ALL SPRING 2026 PROGRAMS</b> All fees due by 4:00 pm, including Fee Deferrals, to avoid deregistration from all courses
<b>December 18</b>	Registration is closed to allow for the processing of all fee payments and to de-register students who have not paid fees or submitted a Fee Deferral. Students who have outstanding fees will be dropped from all courses and waitlists.
<b>December 19</b>	<b>Registration for Spring 2026 continues</b> for students to add or drop classes. On January 3 and 4, students can only add or drop courses online via myCNC.ca or the myCNC app. Full fees are due at time of registration for new courses.
<b>December 25 &amp; 26</b>	<i>Christmas and Boxing Day - College Closed</i>
<b>January 1</b>	<i>New Year's Day - College Closed</i>
