Fall 2023

May 17	Priority Registration times begin for Fall 2023 and Spring 2024
July 3	Canada Day Observed - College Closed
July 26	Fees Due for August start programs in Fall 2023 ABT, Pro Cook, Medical Lab Technology, Foundation Carpentry, Foundation Electrical, Foundation Pipe, & Power Engineering (4th Class)
August 1	Last day to apply pre-requisite requirements to avoid deregistration
August 7	BC Day - College Closed
August 23	Fee Payment Deadline Date for Fall 2023 - All programs. All fees due by 4:00 pm, including Fee Deferrals, to avoid deregistration from all courses.
August 24	Registration is closed to allow for the processing of all fee payments and to deregister students who have not paid fees or submitted a Fee Deferral.
August 25	Registration for Fall 2023 continues for students to Add or Drop classes (Sept 2 - 4 online only). Full fees due at time of registration for new courses.
September 4	Last day to Drop a class and receive full tuition refund less the non-refundable deposit amount (online)
September 4	Labour Day - College Closed
September 5	Orientation Day / First Day of Classes. All waitlists dissolved and empty seats available on first come first served basis.
September 5- 15	Registration for Fall 2023 continues for students to Add or Drop classes
September 5 - 8	Drop a class and receive a 60% tuition refund less the non-refundable deposit amount
September 11 - 15	Drop a class and receive a 40% tuition refund less the non-refundable deposit amount
September 15	Last day to add or drop courses
September 29	Last day to change enrolment to audit status - instructor signature required.
October 2	National Day for Truth and Reconciliation Observed - College Closed
October 9	Thanksgiving Day - College Closed
November 3	Last day to withdraw without academic penalty. After this date students who are not attending and have not officially withdrawn will receive an "F" grade.

December 20	Fee Payment Deadline Date for Spring 2024 - all programs. All fees due by 4:00 pm, including Fee Deferrals, to avoid deregistration from all courses.
December 21	Registration is closed to allow for the processing of all fee payments and to deregister students who have not paid fees or submitted a Fee Deferral. Students who have outstanding fees will be dropped from all courses and waitlists.
December 22	Registration for Spring 2024 continues for students to Add or Drop classes. Full fees due at time of registration for new courses.
December 25 & 26	Christmas—College Closed
January 1	New Year's Day - College Closed
January 7	Last day to DROP a class and receive full tuition refund less non-refundable deposit amount (online)
January 8	First Day of Classes for Spring 2024. All waitlists dissolved and empty seats available on first come first served basis.
January 8 - 19	Registration for Spring 2024 continues for students to Add or Drop classes
January 8 - 12	Drop a class and receive a 60% tuition refund less the non-refundable deposit amount
January 15 - 19	Drop a class and receive a 40% tuition refund less the non-refundable deposit amount
January 19	Last day to add or drop courses
February 2	Last day to change to audit status - instructor signature required
February 19	Family Day - College Closed
February 19- 23	Reading Break for most programs and courses
March 8	Last day to withdraw without academic penalty. After this date students who are not attending and have not officially withdrawn will receive an "F" grade.
March 29— April 1	Good Friday and Easter Monday- College Closed
