





Technology Exploration (TekX) Dual Credit Application Package







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Description

Thank you for your interest in the Technology Exploration (TekX) Dual Credit Program. TekX is a collaboration between the College of New Caledonia (CNC), the University of Northern British Columbia (UNBC), and Cedars Christian School. Throughout the TekX program, you will engage in hands-on learning while expanding your knowledge of current and advancing topics in technology and earn credits at high school and post-secondary at the same time. Upon successful completion of the TekX program, you will graduate with an Associate Certificate in Technology Exploration.

Note that to qualify for dual credit, the British Columbia Ministry of Education requires that the course be approved by an authorized representative of Cedars Christian School before the student registers for the course.

Students interested in TekX must:

- Be in good academic standing.
- Obtain the signature of their principal (or counsellor) and a parent or guardian (if under 18) as part of the
 application process, indicating that their readiness to complete a post-secondary coursework successfully.
- Be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents.

Applications for the TekX program are now open! To secure your place, submit a completed application at least one month before the start of your desired semester. The program is available for the September and January semesters, but seats are limited, and applications may close early once all spots are filled.
