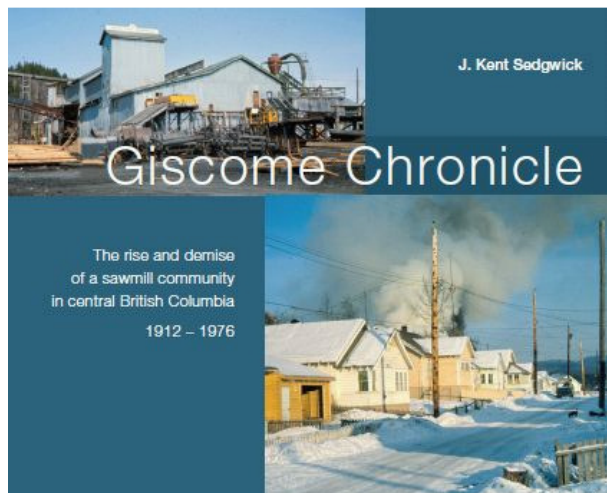

The book includes black and white photos, and a colour photo section with comparison views of some of the buildings and landscape before and after the townsite closure.
