CNC's Board of Governors Appoints Executive

The College of New Caledonia's (CNC) Board of Governors welcomed a new Chair and Vice Chair Prince George following the Board's regular Annual General Meeting (AGM) on April 20.

Gil Malfair, who formally held the position of Vice Chair Prince George and has served on CNC's Board of Governors since December 2016, was appointed Board Chair at the AGM. He replaces Lee Doney, who stepped down from the position but remains on CNC's Board of Governors.

"I would like to extend my gratitude to Lee Doney for his leadership," said Malfair. "The professionalism, talent and passion of the College of New Caledonia's Board members is admirable and I am proud to chair a board that has dedicated so much time and effort to ensuring CNC is the best institution it can be."
