What do I need?

- ⇒ The following courses or their equivalents, with an average GPA of 3.0 ("B") with no grade lower than a "C":
 - ➔ 6 credits of first year Biology (Anatomy and Physiology), must include labs
 - ➔ 6 credits of first year Chemistry, must include labs
 - ➔ 6 credits of first or second year English
 - ➔ 6 credits of first or second year Psychology
 - ➔ 3 credits of first or second year Statistics
 - ➔ 3 credits of first or second year elective
