- ⇒ Anatomy and Physiology 12\*, or equivalent (minimum 73%)
- ⇒ Chemistry 11, or equivalent (minimum 70%)
- ⇒ English Studies 12, or English First Peoples 12, or equivalent (minimum 70%)
- ⇒ Foundations of Mathematics 11, or equivalent (minimum 70%)

\*Anatomy and Physiology 12 or equivalent must be completed within five (5) years prior to the semester of admission to the NCBNP.
