Entry Requirements

1. Minimum successful completion of a 2-year diploma from a recognized post-secondary institution or equivalent, within the past 5 years, in either Computer Science or Business Information Technologies or equivalent.
2. Students whose first language is not English must show proof of a minimum TOEFL score of 80 (IBT), or minimum overall IELTS score of 6.0 or equivalent, or completion of CNC ESL English for Academic Purposes or equivalent

Graduation Requirements

Students must complete all of the 17 courses with a minimum grade of B (72%) in each course in order to graduate with a Post Diploma in Information Technologies.

Prerequisites

In the Post Diploma in Information Technologies program a minimum grade of B (72%) or higher is required for any prerequisite course.
