What do I need?

- ⇒ Successful completion of a recognized bachelor's degree. International students from a non English speaking country will be required to provide proof of a minimum 6.0 Academic IELTS or 80 iBT TOEFL result or equivalent within two years. It is the responsibility of the student to confirm that their bachelor's degree satisfies the degree prerequisite of the CPA Professional Education Program.
