- Minimum successful completion of a 2-year diploma from a recognized post-secondary institution or equivalent.
- Students whose first language is not English must show proof of a minimum IELTS score of 6.0 or equivalent.

Graduation Requirements:

Students must complete all of the 18 courses with a minimum 2.67 GPA (B-) and an "S" grade in THMG 340: Tourism and Hotel Management Practicum, to graduate with a Post Diploma in Tourism and Hotel Management.
