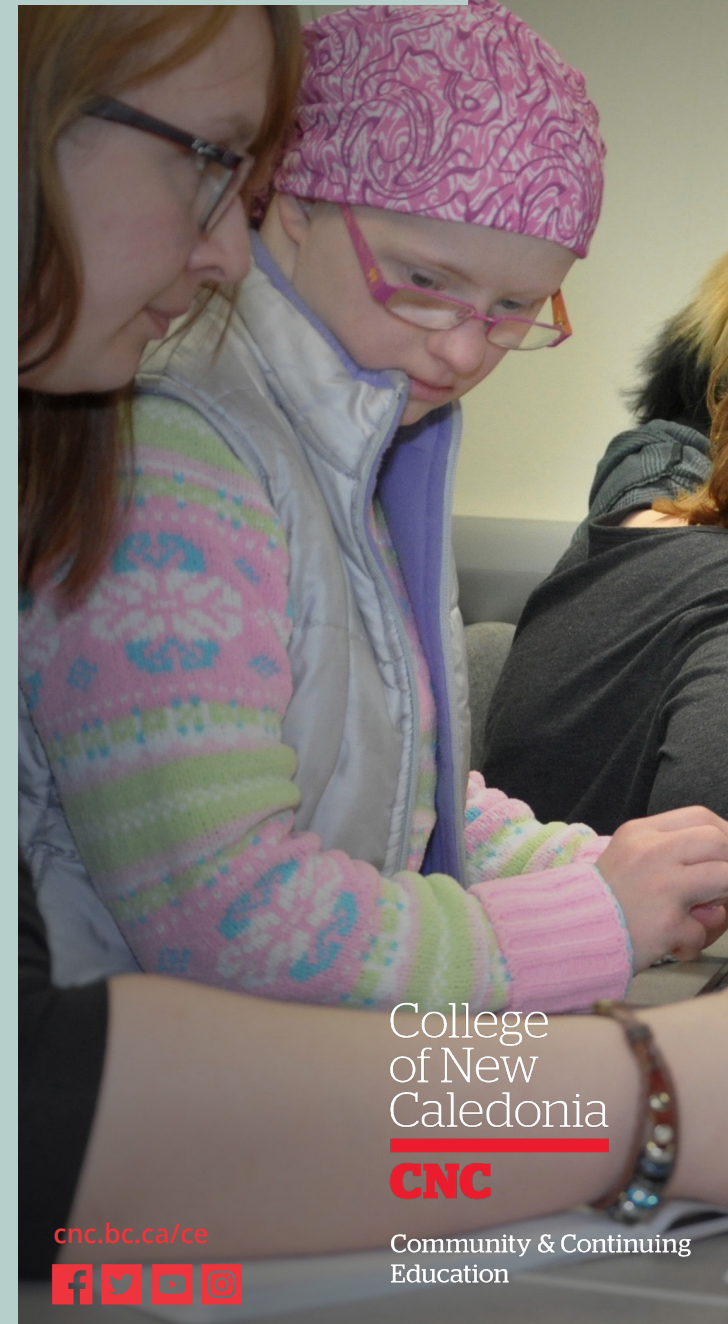

## Program Overview

Adventure Seekers is a part-time, two year program designed for young adults aged 18-30 who have severe to moderate developmental disabilities, have completed their secondary education and have a strong interest in learning.

Through individual and group learning, the goal of Adventure Seekers is to:

- Increase and maintain the functional literacy of each student.
- Support individual growth.
- Increase College and community participation.

Through student consultation, course content reflects topics of relevance and interests of the students. In the past topics have included:

- Current events
- Arts - global music, film and literature
- Computer technology - email, using the Internet safely, and PowerPoint
- Science and mathematics

Courses and delivery are modified to suit individual capabilities and interests. Functional literacy is integrated into the program through focus on:

- Communication skills
- Social skills
- Numeracy skills
- Safety skills

It is expected that students will require a support worker; the provision of the support worker is the participant's responsibility.

## Application Information

### STEP 1

- Submit a completed Adventure Seekers Application for Acceptance form.

### STEP 2

- Attend an intake interview to determine program suitability.

### STEP 3

- Once accepted, complete the CNC registration process and pay fees.

Suitable applicants will be accepted in the order that their application is received.

### ALUMNI APPLICANTS

Families seeking to re-enroll their student for the second year of Adventure Seekers are guaranteed a seat in the class.

Families will be placed on a waiting list if they wish to re-enroll in the Adventure Seekers program after two years, and/or if applicant is 30+ years old. This allows priority seats for new families.

Students considered Adventure Seekers Alumni after they have completed two years in the program or if they are over the age of 30. Should seats remain in the program after the new applicant registration deadline. Alumni will be given an opportunity to apply for one additional year.
