

ENTRANCE GUIDELINES

Adventure Seekers is a two-year, part-time program intended for persons aged 18 – 30 with a severe to moderate developmental disability. It is expected that a support worker will be required for each student; the provision of the support worker will be the responsibility of the student's guardian. Exceptions to this may be made on a case-by-case basis, to be determined by the instructor. Applicants should have completed their secondary education.

APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Complete an Adventure Seekers Application for Acceptance form, available at CNC from the Community & Continuing Education office (1-735) or online on the Adventure Seekers CNC page (search "Adventure Seekers" in the search bar of CNC's homepage)
2. Submit completed form to the Community & Continuing Education office in person (room 1-780) or by fax to 250-561-5856. Or email a scanned copy to the program coordinator at continuing@cnc.bc.ca by May 29, 2020. Applications will be date stamped as they are received.

Applicants will be accepted to the program based on suitability and the order their applications were received.

3. Applications must be submitted before the closing date of May 29, 2020 for the 2020-2021 academic year.
4. To qualify for the program, all applicants must be interviewed by the instructor. Applicants will be contacted for an interview with the Adventure Seekers instructor to determine if the program is suitable for the applicant.
5. If it is determined that the program is suitable for the applicant, and there is space, they will be given a Permission to Register letter. The applicant's family must bring this letter and tuition fees to the Office of the Registrar at CNC, located at the front entrance to the College to officially register for the program.
6. The deadline for registration is June 19, 2020
