Course Overview

The program prepares participants to launch a career as professional drivers. This comprehensive 18-week program includes 1 week of essential skills training, 16 weeks of occupational skills training, and 1 week of job search support. Participants will earn industry certifications including Air Brakes, First Aid, WHMIS, TDG, and Defensive Driver training. This program is delivered in partnership with the Ministry of Social Development and Poverty Reduction.

Additional Information

Candidates must meet the following requirements:

- Be 19 years of age or older
- Hold a valid full-privilege B.C. driver's license (Class 5 or 6) with a minimum of 2 years non-learner driving experience
- Have a clean driving record (fewer than 4 penalty points) and pay all prior fines/debts to ICBC
- Pass a driver's medical examination and vision screening
- Determined eligible by WorkBC
