Course Overview

This first aid safety training meets WorkSafe BC regulations. Topics include AED, C-spine control, respiratory and circulatory emergencies, minor soft tissue injuries, accurate completion of the required documentation, identification and management of stroke, diabetes, seizures and fainting. Students receive their OFA Level 1 tickets, valid for 3 years, upon successful completion of a written exam and practical evaluation by the instructor.
