

Course Overview

Building Service Worker Level 1: Basic Commercial Cleaning (BSW1)

This course constitutes an introduction to the skills required to work in the building service custodial field. Possession of the Certificate is often a prerequisite or preferred qualification for employment for many school boards, recreation centers, institutions and private cleaning companies. Upon completion of this level, the student will receive a Certificate.

Building Service Worker Level 2: Hard Floor Care (BSW2)

This level of BSW familiarizes the student with the techniques, equipment, chemistry and products for floor maintenance. Upon successful completion of the course, the student will receive a Certificate.

Hospitality - Hotel/Camp Attendant

This course is geared to individuals who wish to obtain employment or verify their competency in hotel/motel housekeeping. It helps the student meet the standards established by the Canadian Tourism Human Resource Council and was designed with input from local industry. Students who successfully complete this course will obtain a Certificate.
