This 7-hour WorkSafe BC course is designed to provide life saving first aid skills to workers in industry, including COVID-19 protocols. The course will cover assessment of the injured person, how to deal with obstructed airways, circulatory distress, and control of bleeding.

To qualify for certification the candidate must participate in a minimum of seven hours of training and successfully complete the course objectives as taught and evaluated by a person authorized by the Workers' Compensation (WorkSafe BC).

The successful student will receive a 3-year OFA Level 1 Certificate.

Certificate valid for 3 years. Must be 16 years of age or older. Photo ID is required.
