

WorkSafe BC: OFA Level 1

Course Overview

This 8-hour WorkSafe BC course is designed to provide lifesaving first aid skills to workers in industry, including COVID-19 protocols. The course will cover assessment of the injured person, how to deal with obstructed airways, circulatory distress, and control of bleeding.

To qualify for certification the candidate must participate in a minimum of seven hours of training and successfully complete the course objectives as taught and evaluated by a person authorized by the Workers' Compensation (WorkSafeBC).

The successful student will receive a 3-year OFA Level 1 Certificate.
