

# **Course Overview**

Offers basic first aid and caregiving skills for youth 11-15 years old. Participants learn how to provide care to children in a variety of age groups, and how to prevent and respond to emergencies. .

## **Additional information:**

- Lunch, snacks and refreshments provided
- students receive certification from the Canadian Red Cross
- Students must be 11 years of age (or completion of grade 5)

#### **Course Content:**

- First Aid Content: Check, Call, Care (includes phoning EMS/911), glove removal, recovery position, conscious choking (adult/child/baby/alone), CPR (Baby/Child), illness, asthma including use of inhaler and spacer, anaphylaxis including use of EPI- Pen, poisoning, insect bites, wound care (i.e, minor cuts and scrapes, splinters, nosebleeds, bumps and bruises, life-threatening bleeding, burns) head, neck and back injuries, broken bones and seizures.
- How to promote oneself as a babysitter
- · How to feed, dress, diaper and play with children and babies
- How to recognize and prevent unsafe situations, make safe choices and promote safe behaviours
- How to be responsible and demonstrate leadership
- How to make good decisions and manage difficult behaviours
