This course provides application of the concepts of local anesthesia learned in the theory course. This clinical course gives students the opportunity to learn and practice injections under the supervision of an experienced instructor on the first weekend. The second weekend will consist of an evaluation of all injection techniques. Participants who are successful in the theory and clinical course may be certified as authorized to provide local anesthesia ("C" certification) by the College of Dental Hygienists of British Columbia (CDHBC). This course may also be taken by dental hygienists who need to refresh their skills in local anesthesia administration after completion of the theory course.
