In this course, you will learn about the tools available to help create an inclusive learning environment that is both accessible and effective for all students. The course will introduce you to the three principles of UDL, which are multiple means of representation, multiple means of action and expression, and multiple means of engagement. You will learn how to apply these principles to your teaching practices, including how to design flexible and accessible curricula, assessments, and instructional materials.
