## Course Overview

This 70-hour course provides advanced first aid knowledge and training for WorkSafeBC OFA Level 3 certification.

## Additional Information

Candidates must

- be at least 16 years old,
- have minimal but sufficient upper body strength and knee agility to complete first aid skills and lift patients and equipment,
- pick up an OFA Level 3 binder from the Office of the Registrar and complete homework assignments prior to the course start,
- provide government-approved Photo ID, and
- wear socks and remove footwear in the classroom.

Successful completion requires 100% attendance, participation, and passing grades on the practical and written exams. Certification from WorkSafeBC is valid for 3 years.
