

Where do I go on Convocation Day?

Please report to the Quesnel Campus **no later than 10:15 am**. Students participating in the ceremony need to report to room N207. Detailed instructions and a CNC staff member, to answer your questions about the ceremony, will be available in the room. **The ceremony will begin promptly at 11:00 am, Tuesday, June 4th.**

Valuables should be left with a friend/family member. However, if valuables are left in the classroom the volunteers will lock the door as the grads leave for the procession. You will need to find a volunteer to unlock the door for you at the end of the ceremony.

What happens during the ceremony?

The order of events will be outlined in the program. You will be led in as a procession and guided to the reserved seating area for grads. Please remain standing for the opening prayer and the singing of O Canada. You are expected to remain seated until the end of the ceremony, as the entire group will march out in a procession to have a group photo taken. Further direction and details for the procession, ceremony, and photo will be posted in room N207.

How about photos?

- There will be a group photo of all the graduates, faculty, and dignitaries after the ceremony.
- Group photos of each graduating class will be taken after the group photo.
- Group photos will be available on the convocation website a few weeks after convocation. Ceremony pictures will be available in due course to students at Q:\Course Material\Grad Photos\2019.

What do the gowns look like?

The CNC gown is burgundy, and you will receive a burgundy mortar board and gold tassel as a keepsake. Convocation is a formal event and we suggest wearing semi-formal business attire under the gown. Please keep in mind when deciding what to wear to the event that gowns will fall below the knee so your lower legs will be visible.

When and where can I pick up my cap and gown?

Caps and gowns can be picked up at the Office of the Registrar, May 28, 29, 30 and June 3.
Office of the Registrar hours are Monday to Thursday, 9:00 am – 4:00 pm
Gowns that are not picked up in advance will be available in Room N207 on June 4th.

When is the reception?

Please join us with your guests at the reception, which starts after the ceremony. Refreshments and light snacks will be provided.

When will I get my credential?

During the ceremony you'll receive your official credential if you've met your graduation requirements.
