This course provides an introduction to the Dakelh language, focusing on basic vocabulary, grammar, and conversational skills. Students will explore the Dakelh language structure, including phonetics, sentence structure, and common words used in everyday communication. Cultural contexts and traditions of the Dakelh people will be included in the curriculum to enhance students' understanding and appreciation of the language. By the end of the course, students will have foundational knowledge of Dakelh, enabling them to participate in basic conversations and understand important language elements. This course is suitable for beginners with no prior knowledge of Dakelh.
