

CNC Executive Study Abroad Scholarship Application

In partnership with the Office of the President, CNC International Education department has established the Executive Study Abroad Scholarship to support CNC students in pursuing Study Abroad opportunities.

The Executive Study Abroad Scholarship is awarded to eligible students participating in a CNC Study Abroad program. The award varies in amount, ranging from \$500 to \$3000.

Eligibility criteria:

- Be enrolled as a full-time CNC student for at least one semester;
- Have been accepted into an eligible for credit CNC Study Abroad program;
- Have an academic standing suitable to Study Abroad (GPA of 3.0 or higher);
- Have a sincere interest in international and inter-cultural learning;
- Have not previously received an Executive Study Abroad Scholarship from CNC.

Application Requirements:

- Submit a letter demonstrating your readiness to go abroad, detailing volunteerism, cross-cultural experience, community engagement, and campus involvement. You must additionally provide a link between your chosen study abroad opportunity and your educational goals.
- Submit your most recent transcript, if you haven't already done so with your general study abroad application (does not need to be an official transcript).

Evaluation:

Applicants will be evaluated based on their GPA and quality of application letter. Preference may be given to participants who have not participated in a study abroad program before.

Additional Criteria

- Must be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Be enrolled in a program of at least one-year in duration, offering a credential upon successful completion
- Have an academic standing suitable to the study abroad program
- Have been accepted into the study abroad program
- Not be carrying out their study abroad activity in a country from which he/she has immigrated within the last 10 years
- Be planning to carry out the study abroad activity outside Canada
- Be able to demonstrate links between the study abroad experience and educational goals
- Have preferably demonstrated involvement on campus and/or community
- Have not received an Executive Scholarship previously at the credential level
