It will help them understand how to prevent problems, handle real life situations, and keep them safe and constructively occupied.

This course focuses on small group discussions, problem solving, role playing, and instructor led demonstrations. The course material covers topics such as: establishing a routine, house key responsibility, strangers, telephone safety, emergencies, basic first aid, and internet safety.
