

## **CNC Study Abroad Bursary Application**

The CNC International Education Department has established Study Abroad Bursaries to support CNC students in pursuing Study Abroad opportunities.

CNC Study Abroad Bursaries are awarded to eligible students participating in a CNC Study Abroad program. The award amount is \$500.

Eligibility criteria:

- Be enrolled as a full-time CNC student (domestic or international student) for at least one semester;
- Have been accepted into an eligible CNC Study Abroad program;
- Have an academic standing suitable to Study Abroad (GPA 2.5 or higher);
- Have a sincere interest in international and inter-cultural learning;
- Have not previously received a Study Abroad Bursary from CNC

Application Requirements:

- You must submit, as part of your general Study Abroad application:
  - Letter of intent detailing the importance and your involvement in international activities
  - Most recent transcript (not official)
  - Reference form

Evaluation:

Preference may be given to participants who have never received an award for study abroad activities or have been abroad before.

Additional Criteria

- Must be a Canadian Citizen, Permanent Resident, or have a valid Study Permit
- Be enrolled in a program of at least one-year in duration, offering a credential upon successful completion
- Have an academic standing suitable to the study abroad program
- Have been accepted into the study abroad program
- Not be carrying out their study abroad activity in a country from which he/she has immigrated within the last 10 years
- Be planning to carry out the study abroad activity outside Canada
- Be able to demonstrate links between the study abroad experience and educational goals
- Have preferably demonstrated involvement on campus and/or community
- Have not received an Executive Scholarship previously at the credential level
