Additional Information

Candidates must

- Be at least 16 years of age,
- Have minimal but sufficient upper body strength and knee agility to complete first aid skills and lift patients and equipment,
- Be able to perform the first aid skills required,
- Provide government-approved Photo ID, and
- Wear socks and remove footwear in the classroom.

Tuition: \$350, including course manual.

Previous course name: Occupational First Aid Level 2.

No previous first aid training is required.

Successful completion requires 100% participation and attendance, competency performing all first aid skills, and passing the written exam.
