



Intermediate First Aid

Course Overview

Our Intermediate First Aid course, replacing **Occupational First Aid Level 2**, is designed for those who want to take their first aid skills to the next level. This course is ideal for ensuring workplace safety and preparing employees to handle more complex emergencies effectively.

The training equips you to handle scenarios with more severe injuries or multiple casualties. Over two days, you'll learn advanced techniques like handling chest & abdominal injuries and performing rescue carries, ensuring you're prepared for any emergency.

Duration

Two-day (16 hours) *Must be 16+ years of age.
