

Course Overview

This 7-hour WorkSafe BC course is designed to provide life saving first aid skills to workers in industry. The course will cover assessment of the injured person, how to deal with obstructed airways, circulatory distress, and control of bleeding.

To qualify for certification the candidate must be 16 years+, participate in a minimum of seven hours of training and successfully complete the course objectives as taught and evaluated by a person authorized by the Workers' Compensation (WorkSafe BC).
