



Occupational First Aid Level 2

Course Overview

This 35-hour course provides advanced first aid knowledge and training for WorkSafeBC OFA Level 2 certification. Successful students receive a 3-year Worksafe BC certificate.

Additional Information

Candidates must

- Be at least 16 years of age,
- Have minimal but sufficient upper body strength and knee agility to complete first aid skills and lift patients and equipment,
- Be able to perform the first aid skills required,
- Provide government-approved Photo ID, and
- Wear socks and remove footwear in the classroom.

35 hours
October 9 - 13

No previous first aid training is required, but is suggested.

Successful completion requires 100% participation and attendance, competency performing all first aid skills, and a passing grade on the written exam.
