Occupational First Aid Level 3 is a 70-hour (excluding breaks) program designed for remote worksites or employees with large workforces more than 20 minutes from medical aid. Successful participants will be qualified to work as a WorkSafe BC OFA Level 3 first aid attendant.

Materials must be picked up prior to course commencement. Participants are required to complete required pre-reading before the first day.

To be successful in the course, participants must achieve 70% or higher in both practical and written exams.

Certificated valid for 3 years. Must be 16 years of age or older. Photo ID is required.
