Course Overview

The purpose of the Transportation of Dangerous Goods (TDG) Act and Regulations is to promote public safety when dangerous goods are being handled, offered for transport or transported by road, rail, air, or water (marine). The Transportation of Dangerous Goods course is required before handling, offering for transport, transporting or importing dangerous goods, or directing others to do the same.
