

"Add Yours" Convocation Contest – Prince George Convocation Ceremony Terms and Conditions:

Contest Eligibility:

1. HOW TO ENTER

No purchase necessary. To enter the contest, students must participate in the "Add Yours" Instagram story challenge shared by the College of New Caledonia prior to and during Convocation, on June 5, 2025. Participants are required to use CNC's official template and post a story featuring six unique photos from their Convocation day, including:

- A photo at Convocation, at the CN Centre on June 5th 2025
- A selfie at Convocation, at the CN Centre on June 5th 2025
- A photo of the Convocation stage, at the CN Centre on June 5th 2025
- A cupcake at Convocation, at the CN Centre on June 5th 2025
- The Alumni keychain, at the CN Centre on June 5th 2025
- The balloon toss at Convocation, at the CN Centre on June 5th 2025

To be considered, students must tag @collegeofnewcaledonia. If your account is private and you have not tagged CNC in your submission, your submission will not be valid.

Limit of one entry per person.

Deadline to enter:

• Prince George ceremony: June 9, 2025, 4:00 PM PST

2. ELIGIBILITY

The contest is open to anyone who is part of CNC's graduating class of 2025 and attended CNC convocation ceremony on June 5, 2025.

The contest is not open to directors and employees of College of New Caledonia. CNC reserves the right to cancel or amend the contest at any time. Decisions made by CNC are final and binding.

3. WINNER SELECTION



Eligible entries will be reviewed on a rolling basis. The first 30 eligible entries from the Prince George convocation ceremony will be selected.

Selected students will be contacted by CNC via Instagram and must respond within five (5) business days with their full name, student number, and sweater size.

Eligibility will be verified by CNC's Marketing and Events team in coordination with the Office of the Registrar. Failure to respond or confirm details within the specified time will result in forfeiture of the prize, and the next eligible participant may be contacted.

4. DESCRIPTION OF PRIZE

There are a total of thirty (30) prizes to be awarded:

Thirty (30) CNC custom sweaters for eligible Prince George entrants Approximate retail value: \$40 CAD

Prizes are to be picked up at the student's home campus. If the student is unable to pick up the prize, they may send a friend or family member in their place. If this is not possible, the prize will be mailed, within BC, to them at the expense of CNC. If the student lives outside of BC, they will be responsible to cover the cost of shipping.

No cash value or substitutions. Prizes are non-transferable.

If after awarding the contest prize, an entrant is disqualified or determined to be ineligible, an alternate winner will be selected using the same process described above. Alternate winners are subject to all contest rules.
