VENDOR INFORMATION:

1. Due to limited space, applications will be considered on a first-applied, first-placed basis. We will try our best to accommodate every vendor, and will contact all applicants on **Thursday, March 14th, 2024.**
2. One (1) large table will be provided to each vendor. All other materials necessary for your display are your own responsibility, including extension cords, bas, etc.
3. Doors will open at 8:00 am for vendors to set up their booth. Booth set up must be completed by 9:45 am.
4. Doors will closed to the public at 4:00 pm.
5. All vendors are responsible for take down of their booth by 5:00 pm.

6. Vendors are required to remain open for the entire duration of the event (10:00 am – 4:00 pm)
7. Vendors must be Indigenous to apply for a booth at this event, and only Indigenous/Indigenous-themed product/craft is permitted for sale.
8. Vendors are responsible for their own cash and product handling. CNC will not have access to cash, nor be able to make change.
9. There is **no fee** to be a vendor in the Indigenous Artisan Market or to attend the event.
