Education Backed by Support

From tuition to textbooks, housing, and wellness support, CNC helps current and former youth in care focus on their education.

Provincial Tuition Waiver

Have your tuition and eligible fees covered. Available to current and former youth in care. No age limit.

Learning for Future Grant

Receive an additional \$3,500 per year to help with textbooks, supplies, and other education costs.

Youth Futures Education Fund (YFEF)

Extra support for students using the Tuition Waiver. Helps with textbooks, housing, food, utilities, and other daily expenses. Available once per semester.

Who's Eligible?

Former youth in care who spent at least 24 months in care with the Ministry of Children and Family Development or a Delegated Aboriginal Agency and are attending a BC public post-secondary institution (or the Native Education College).
