Resources to support Former Youth In Care



Provincial Tuition Waiver

Have your tuition and eligible school fees covered. This program is for students who are current and former youth in care studying full-time or part-time in an eligible program or course below the graduate level.

There is no age restriction on this program.

Learning for Future Grant



A **\$3,500** per program year grant that is available to full-time or part-time students who meet the criteria for the Provincial Tuition Waiver and are enrolled in an eligible program or course below the graduate level.



The grant is to assist with additional education related costs that are not already covered by the Provincial Tuition Waiver (including text-books, computers, and school supplies).



Youth Futures Education Fund (YFEF)

A small grant once per semester for eligible students who are attending school on the Provincial Tuition Waver.



CNC Entrance Awards

Ranging from \$500 to \$2,000 these scholarships and bursaries are available to new students so they can focus on what matters most: their education and success.

Strengthening Abilities and Journeys of Empowerment (SAJE)

Youth and young adults who have been in government care in British Columbia can access supports and services available to them as they transition from care.

SAJE is available to eligible youth aged 19 to 26 years (up to their 27th birthday). SAJE also provides pre-19 planning support.

SAJE Navigators and Guides can help with income supports, housing supports, health and wellness supports, as well as life-skills, training and cultural connections supports and funding.
