Program Overview

The College of New Caledonia prepares the next generation of creative and intellectual leaders through a specialized, two-year Associate of Arts Degree. We offer concentrations in Commerce, English, Psychology and Sociology.

This program prepares students for further education in the humanities and social sciences by exposing them to a variety of university-level subjects, with a focus on the arts. The Associate of Arts Degree is **equivalent to the first two years of a university degree**, at a fraction of the cost.

Admission Requirements

Applicants require proof of successful completion of the following:

- 1 High school, or the equivalent of BC Grade 12 with English 12 minimum "C" grade
- 2 Minimum TOEFL score of 80 (IBT) or minimum overall academic IELTS score of 6.0 or equivalent, or successful completion of CNC's English for Academic Purposes (EAP) 3
