Program Overview

The Post Diploma in Human Resources Management is a two-year program that provides students with an in-depth understanding of human resources management topics to become supervisors, managers and human resource professionals.

This program includes a capstone project or management practicum in the final semester of study. In both options, students will be able to apply and synthesize theoretical concepts learned during the previous coursework. The courses for this program are spread over four semesters allowing students a manageable course load.
