Program Overview

The College of New Caledonia prepares the next generation of creative and intellectual leaders through a specialized two-year Associate of Science Degree program. We offer concentrations in Biology and Chemistry. This program prepares students for further education in the science disciplines by exposing them to a variety of university-level subjects, such as Biology, Chemistry, and Mathematics, but also incorporating English and Social Sciences for a balanced education. The Associate of Science Degree is **equivalent to the first two years of a university degree**, at a fraction of the cost.

CNC's Science students graduate with a wide range of transferable skills which are applicable in the professional world. These skills, such as professional communication, research and planning, critical thinking, analytical assessment, scientific and mathematical reasoning, and the application of theoretical understanding, all provide key competencies to industry-specific skills for employment.

Admission Requirements

Applicants require proof of successful completion of the following:

- 1 High school, or the equivalent of BC Grade 12 with English 12 minimum "C" grade
- 2 Strong grades in Math and the relevant science subjects, such as Biology, Chemistry, and Physics
- 3 Minimum TOEFL score of 80 (IBT) or minimum overall academic IELTS score of 6.0 or equivalent, or successful completion of CNC's English for Academic Purposes (EAP) 3
