



CNC Study Abroad Bursary Application

The CNC International Education Department has established Study Abroad Bursaries to support CNC students in pursuing Study Abroad opportunities.

CNC Study Abroad Bursaries are awarded to eligible students participating in a CNC Study Abroad program. The awards of \$500 will be distributed four times per year.

Eligibility criteria:

- Be enrolled as a full-time CNC student (domestic or international student) for at least one semester;
- Have been accepted into an eligible CNC Study Abroad program;
- Have an academic standing suitable to Study Abroad (GPA OR 3.0 or higher);
- Have a sincere interest in international and inter-cultural learning;
- Have not previously received a Study Abroad Bursary from CNC

Application Requirements:

- Applicants are asked to submit a short letter detailing the importance or value of their Study Abroad program.
- Applicants are required to submit a recent transcript.

Evaluation:

Applicants will be evaluated based on their GPA and quality of application letter. Preference may be given to participants who have never been abroad before.
