AUDIT STATUS

Policy Statement

This policy establishes guidelines and criteria to give students the opportunity to enroll in a course without receiving credit (audit).

Purpose / Rationale

To provide students with the opportunity to take a course for self-interest and academic exploration, not for credit.

Scope / Limits

This policy applies to all students enrolled in Education Council approved course(s).

Principles / Guidelines

- 1. The College values and promotes the principles of student success and academic progression and is committed to working with students to achieve their educational goals.
- 2. Students are encouraged to seek relevant advice from an Academic Advisor prior to auditing a course or changing their enrolment status to "Audit" as this may not be possible in all programs/courses.
- 3. Students are responsible for any deadlines associated with their change in enrolment status.
- 4. Regular course withdrawal deadlines and processes apply for students withdrawing from a course with an audit status.
- 5. Students must pay all applicable fees associated with the course.
- 6. Courses taken on an "Audit" status are not considered part of the student's official workload.
- 7. No course credits are earned for an audited course.
- 8. Audited courses are noted on the transcript with AUD.

- 9. Audited courses cannot be used to meet pre-requisites or co-requisites to other courses, nor can they be used to meet program credential requirements.
- 10. The degree of participation in a course for an audit student is at the discretion of the instructor.
