Academic and clinical demands will require an understanding of computer information systems. A willingness to work evening, weekend, nights, and on call shifts. The ability to work with needles, body fluids and biopsy tissue collection. Awareness that the clinical setting has a variety of scenarios; applicants must be able to deal with disturbing situations such as trauma patients, surgical procedures and acutely ill patients. A willingness to accept clinical placement at off campus sites at various Radiology Departments in Northern British Columbia. There will be three rotations of clinical placement sites.
