Strong problem solving skills, good interpersonal skills and the ability to function well as part of a team. Good time management and organizational skills, including the ability to multi-task and prioritize. Awareness that medical radiography work is demanding, both physically and mentally. Individuals must be able to cope well in a stressful environment and be physically able to perform all duties. Applicant must have proficient oral and written English communication skills in order to communicate effectively with patients and the healthcare team. The ability to use word processing programs and electronic communication (internet, etc). Academic and clinical demands will require an understanding of computer information systems. A willingness to work evening, weekend, nights, and on call shifts. The ability to work with needles, body fluids and biopsy tissue collection. Awareness that the clinical setting has a variety of scenarios; applicants must be able to deal with disturbing situations such as trauma patients, surgical procedures and acutely ill patients. A willingness to accept clinical placement at off campus sites at various Radiology Departments in Northern British Columbia. There will be three rotations of clinical placement sites. Awareness of the CAMRT Professional Code of Conduct and willingness to follow this code while in the CNC program (https://www.camrt.ca/mrt-profession/professional-resources/code-of-ethics/).
