**Project Title:** Dementia Guidelines for Regional and Indigenous Populations in Northern BC

### **Project description**

The research project will meaningfully engage the communities of Northern BC to gain an understanding of their needs and concerns about Dementia, and to develop psycho-social guidelines that are relevant to Northern BC. This will adapt the existing guidelines into a final product that is culturally appropriate and culturally safe for use in the Northern BC community. We will do surveys to collect information from general public and post-secondary students in northern BC. We will also engage with the communities in these regions to develop consultation groups.
