- 1) Collect the evidence
- 2) Request the student's misconduct history
- 3) Schedule a meeting with the student

No corrective consequences or sanction is required.



You may apply a **CORRECTIVE CONSEQUENCE** to **support student learning** and avoid future violations.



File a **SANCTION**

Level 1&2 at your discretion. Level 3&4 forward to the Dean.



IDEAS:

- written letter of warning
- letter of apology to the author(s)
- reduced grade
- redo the assignment
- make-up assignment
- complete Academic Integrity course



SANCTIONS:

- Level 1) Zero on the assignment
- Level 2) Failing grade for the course
- Level 3) Removal from the course or program
- Level 4) Suspension from the College
