Note: New students will only have access to CNC Connect prior to their first class beginning



CNC Wireless (Wi-Fi)	<p>CNC Campus has free wireless internet for current students. There are two networks available:</p> <p>CNC Secure (recommended): This network remembers your login and automatically logs you in when you enter the CNC Wi-Fi zone.</p> <p>CNC: This network requires you to log in when you enter the CNC Wi-Fi zone.</p>

CNC Email	<p>All CNC students are assigned a CNC email account when they enroll at the college. The college will use this email address to send you course and college information while you attend CNC.</p> <p>You can log into your email account by going to https://owa.cnc.bc.ca and entering your CNC login. You can also navigate to the email login page by clicking 'Email' under Current Students on the CNC home page. Your CNC email address is your CNC username@cnc.bc.ca</p>
